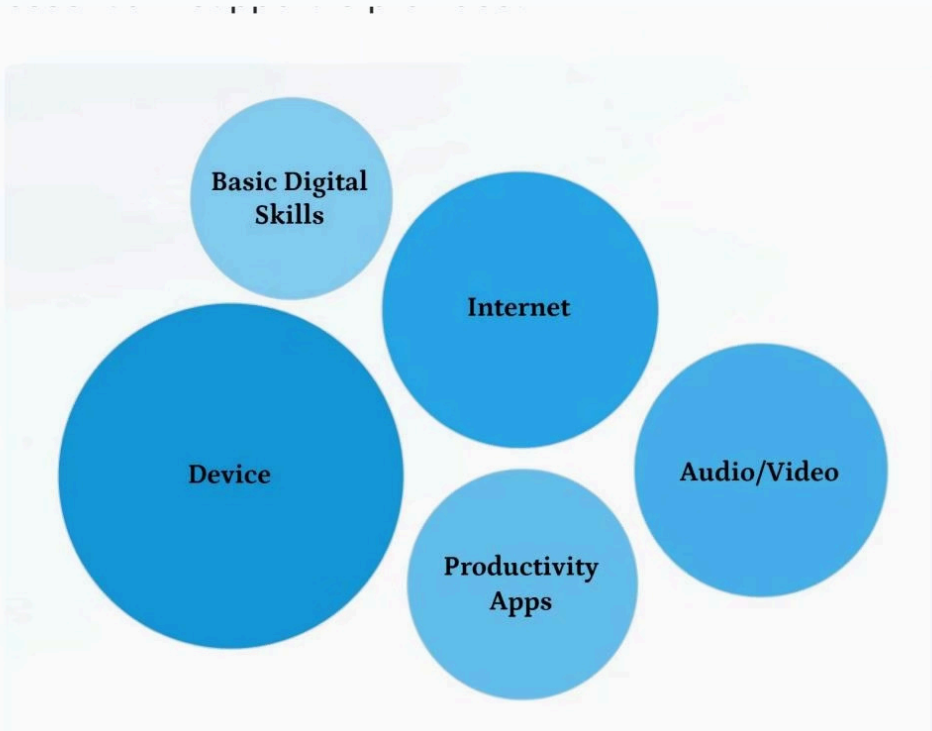

Assessment Strategies

The BSB80120 Graduate Diploma of Management (Learning) uses a structured, competency-based assessment approach designed to measure each learner's ability to apply required knowledge and skills in practical and professional contexts. All assessments reflect realistic, contemporary workplace scenarios relevant to the Australian business environment.

All assessments are conducted online through the IOIS Learning Management System (LMS), with trainer and assessor interaction provided via Microsoft Teams. Assessment tasks are aligned with the requirements of each unit of competency and provide multiple opportunities to demonstrate your capabilities.

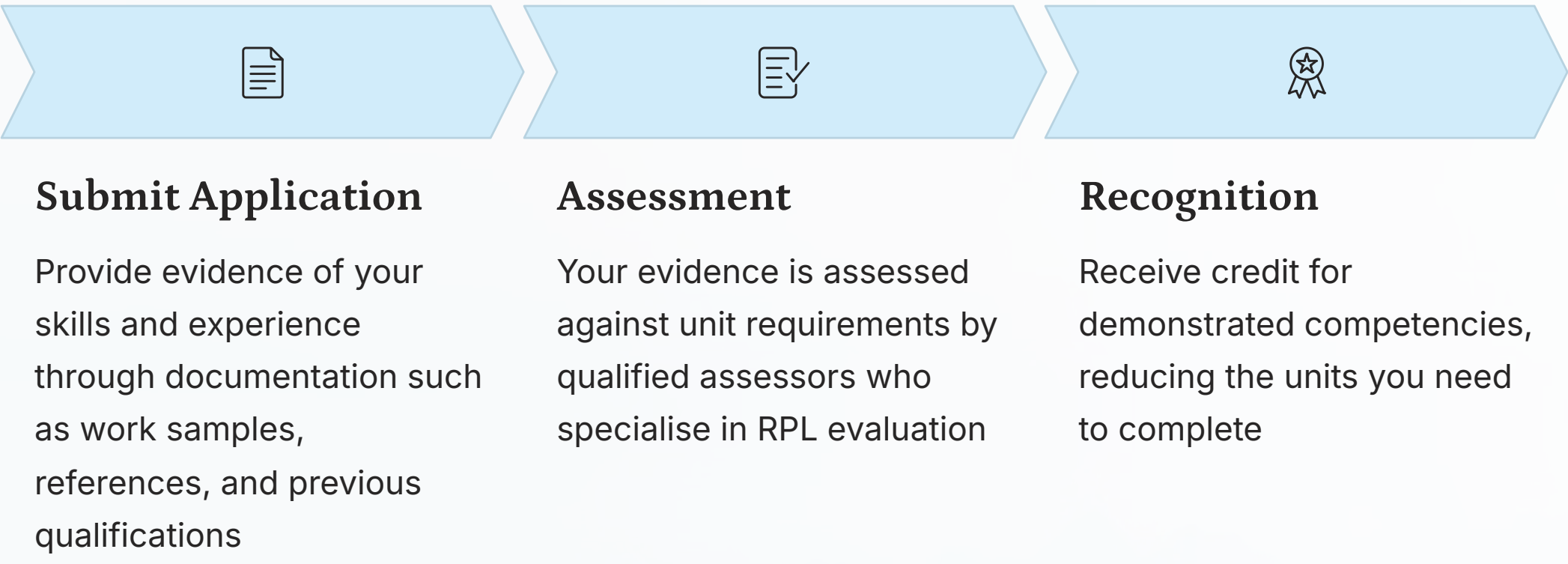
Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Already Have Relevant Experience?

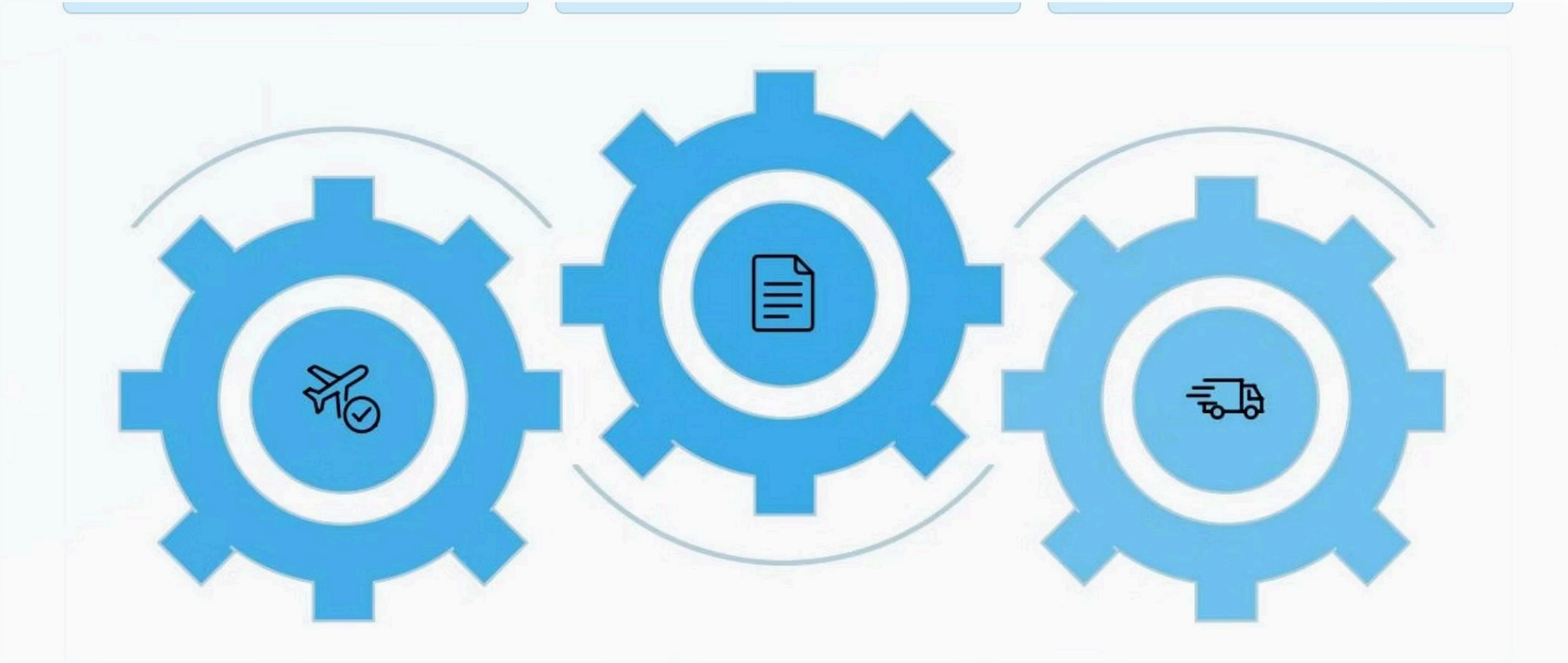


You may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning, which acknowledges your existing skills and knowledge developed through workplace experience, informal or formal training, or other life experiences. Learners with relevant experience may apply for RPL rather than completing all units from scratch. This pathway recognises the valuable capabilities you've already developed outside formal education settings, potentially reducing your study time and cost.

RPL applications are assessed against unit of competency requirements, and sufficient evidence must be provided. An RPL assessment plan will be developed in consultation with each candidate to ensure a fair and thorough evaluation process tailored to your individual circumstances.



Credit Transfer



Already completed relevant units at another registered training organisation? You may be eligible for credit transfer, fast-tracking your pathway to qualification and avoiding unnecessary duplication of learning. Learners who have successfully completed identical units of competency as part of another nationally recognised qualification or Statement of Attainment will be granted credit transfer. This streamlined process recognises your previous achievements and allows you to focus on new learning areas.
